Golden Bear Sighting in Puerto Penasco

At the end of March, the legendary Jack Nicklaus was in Puerto Penasco to officially open the Peninsula De Cortez at the Mayan Palace. This Nicklaus Legacy Course was designed by Jack and his son Jack II. An inauguration tournament was held on March 28. The event included \$250,000 worth of prizes, a golf clinic hosted by Jack Nicklaus followed by a cocktail hour with Jack and his son.

The Peninsula De Cortez Golf Course is an 18 hole, par 72 sand dune course surrounded by flora, fauna and 3 kilometers of beach front on the Sea of Cortez. This is a challenging course that is completely surrounded by water. Almost every hole has wind-swept views of the sea or the natural estuary.

Within the next 10 - 15 years Puerto Penasco will certainly become a world class golf destination. There are currently three golf courses playable and between 8 to 10 championship golf courses are in various stages of planning.
